Please note that after covering auditorium rental & event preparation costs (tickets, trophies, brochures), ALL proceeds from the event go to support school projects adopted by OSAAT. We thank you in advance for helping in our cause.

TICKETS:

- General admission: 2-day pass: \$25 per person & Single day pass (dance or music): \$15 per person (no reserved seating)
- Patron tickets: 2-day pass: \$100 & Single day pass: \$50. (no reserved seating)
- Children below 2 years are free as long as they don't occupy a seat.
- Every team/entry will get one complimentary ticket for the director.

Question: I am part of a group participating in the contest. Should I buy a ticket?

Answer: Yes. **Everyone** as a part of any group participating in the contests must purchase a ticket to the event. There is no team registration fee.

Question: I am part of a group participating in the showcase. Should I buy a ticket?

Answer: Yes. **Everyone** as a part of any group participating in the showcase category must purchase a ticket to the event. There is no team registration fee.

Question: I am participating in more than one category. Should I buy a ticket for each entry?

Answer: No. You need to purchase only one ticket, regardless of how many times you will be performing.

Question: My daughter is part of a group participating in the contest. I need to come to the event to help her dress for the contest. Should I buy a ticket?

Answer: ALL parents and support personnel helping the contestants with costumes or lighting or setting up props or instruments must purchase tickets to enter the auditorium to watch the event. No one will be allowed in the auditorium without a valid ticket.

Question: Should I buy a ticket for my 6 year old child?

Answer: Kids 2 years of age or under will be allowed to attend the event free of charge. All others must purchase tickets.

Question: When and where can I buy the tickets?

Answer: Online ticketing will be enabled in the first week of Jan 2012. at www.osaat.org , OR, through designated OSAAT volunteers or email puttubuggi@gmail.com and Handigol@gmail.com for tickets.



Policy on Photography and videotaping

Question: Can I take photographs or videotape the show?

Answer: Below are the various scenarios:

- Depending upon the rules of the auditorium we rent, flash photography and videotaping may be allowed with some restrictions. The information will be provided along with all the logistical details, closer to the date of the event.
- Some schools do not want their performances taped by anyone other than their own participants' families. In such cases, appropriate announcements will be made prior to their performance to the audience. However, we will not police such requests and ***are not responsible for any blatant disregard of such requests/announcements.*** If you have any reservations about anyone videotaping your performance, we suggest that you do not participate in the contests.
- As the event organizer, OSAAT will photograph and videotape the entire show. OSAAT reserves the right to use any video or photographs, for any purpose including but not limited to publicity such as post-event coverage, newsletters, advertisements, etc.
